We remain deeply committed to the health and well-being of our community, our guests and our associates.

In response to this developing public health concern, we have taken certain precautionary measures to help mitigate the spread of the virus by:

- Conducting enhanced cleaning procedures, while increasing the frequency of sanitizing, in line with recommendations from the Public Health Agency of Canada.
- Offering phone and email arrangements to meet the needs of families and guests.
- Adjusting services and number of guest in attendance according to the directives of local and provincial authorities.

Windsor Memorial Gardens will remain open to families wishing to visit a loved one's burial lot.

Windsor Grove Cemetery is closed until further notice.

For lot interments and crypt entombments, casketed remains will be placed on a cemetery device or carriage, committal prayers will be completed, if requested, and thereafter patrons will be invited to leave - allowing our staff to complete the interment or burial.

- Be aware that where grounds crews and equipment will be required to facilitate casket or urn burials, a physical barrier as determined by the operator will be present (6 feet beyond maximum reach of our equipment)

- Individuals will be permitted to approach the grave to place flowers on the casket once our employees have had the opportunity to distance themselves a minimum of 6 feet.

All attendees will be required to adhere to the Safe Distance Protocol maintaining at least 6 feet from our staff at all times
